

SALEM WOODS CIVIC ASSOCIATION BOARD MEETING

Old Business: There was no old business to discuss.

VicePresident, Sean Butcher

Discussion on the following matters:

New umbrellas and chairs are needed for the pool. Kenny, Joanne and Sean Butcher volunteered to help clean up the facilities, fix the downspouts, broken light at the office entrance etc. when Scott sets a date. No updates on light in parking lot at the office. Pete has floodlights pointing the office direction to help temporarily light up the area.

A proposal to use Allied Landscape (the company that we have the lawn contract with) to mulch the beds at the office and put edging in around all the beds was seconded and passed by the Board.

Treasurer, Heidi Rosen

Heidi presented the income and expenses for March. We currently have a little over \$6,000 in the checkbook.

We have received about 10 family pool memberships so far and 2 Non-resident family memberships. Our SWCA memberships total 212 so far. Income for the month was \$1,235.00 and expenses were \$2,614.00.

Kenny reported two new neighbors that have moved in on his street and on Round Hill. We discussed sending out pool membership flyers for residents and non-residents via Rosemont Forest Elementary School and Glenwood Elementary. Kathy will get them printed and Joanne and Heidi will distribute.

Webmaster, Dustin Sievers

Swim Team, Joanne & Sean Butcher

The first registration on May 1st was very successful...about 35 Swim Team memberships! The next registration will be May 15th at the clubhouse from 10 – noon. The Consignment fundraiser held at Fairfield Shopping Center in the old Blockbuster Bldg, brought in \$1000.00! Swim Team would like to hold another fundraiser in September. Joanne gave us a calendar of SWST events, practices etc. She suggested that it would be great to have community support of neighbors at the meets! She would like to have Scott or the lifeguards let her know if the chemical balance is off in the pool before practices and meets so it can be balanced correctly beforehand.

Recreation, General Discussion

We discussed the Grand Opening of the Pool on May 29th. The pool will open at noon with food being served from 1 – 3 p.m. The following food options were discussed: Sub sandwiches, burgers, hot dogs, ice cream and drinks.
